

Crossroads Summer Camp Info & Attendee Agreement

We will leave from Wellborn Baptist promptly at **5:00am** on Monday, July 8th (whether you're here or not) and will be traveling in rented vans. We will be returning from Crossroads summer camp on Friday, July 12th arriving back at Wellborn Baptist around **6:30pm**. **Your student will need money for breakfast and lunch Monday and for lunch on the trip back. (\$20-\$30)**

What to bring...

- **Bible** (paper kind) & 2 pens
- Snacks
- Toiletries (toothbrush, toothpaste, **deodorant**, soap, etc.)
- Bedding (sleeping bag, pillow), 2 towels
- Casual Clothes (see Crossroads rules)
- Sports Clothes (see Crossroads rules)
- Pajamas (see Crossroads rules)
- Bathing Suit (see Crossroads rules)
- SUNSCREEN

What not to bring...

- Immoral clothing (don't dress like you are for sale or advertise sin) *see Crossroads rules
- Excessive money (there's not that much to buy)
- Valuables (excessive Jewelry, stuff you don't want lost/stolen)
- Alcohol, tobacco, drugs, drug paraphernalia, electronic cigarettes, medicines, etc.
 - Prescription or OTC medications must be checked in with Alex by your parent
- Weapons, airsoft, fireworks, fixed blade knives, incendiary devices, harmful chemicals, lasers, etc.
- Video games, movies, profane music or images, magazines, animals (especially monkeys), etc.
- A bad attitude, disrespect, vulgarity, body odor, etc.

Cell phones

It is recommended that Cell phones, iPods, etc. are left at home. If they are brought on the trip they will stay locked away from the moment we arrive at camp until the moment we depart from camp. Parents & Students can call/use chaperone phones as needed.
